MOTION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Broadview Networks, Inc. ("Broadview"), by undersigned counsel, hereby respectfully moves, pursuant to Section 541-A:32 of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated and Section 203.02 of the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, for leave to intervene and participate as a full party in the above-captioned proceeding.

Broadview is a competitive local exchange carrier certified by the Commission and operating in the State of New Hampshire. In order to serve its New Hampshire customers, Broadview maintains network facilities and multiple collocation arrangements within the State. Broadview also secures various network facilities from Verizon New Hampshire, both as unbundled network elements and otherwise.

Accordingly, Broadview's rights, duties, privileges, immunities and other substantial interests may, and likely will, be affected by the outcome of this proceeding.
