Conversent Communications of New Hampshire, LLC (“Conversent”) petitions to intervene in this proceeding.

Conversent is a competitive local exchange carrier duly authorized to provide such services in New Hampshire. Conversent provides such services in part through high-capacity loops and dedicated transport unbundled network elements (UNEs) acquired from Verizon New Hampshire (“Verizon”).

Conversent’s rights, duties, privileges, immunities or other substantial interests may be affected by this proceeding. The issues under investigation directly affect the extent to which Conversent may obtain various loop and transport UNEs in Verizon’s wire centers, and, therefore, the extent to which Conversent can offer its services in particular areas of the State.

The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings will not be impaired by allowing Conversent to intervene. The Commission has just opened this docket, and Conversent’s petition is in accordance with the schedule that the Commission established.

For these reasons, Conversent requests that it be permitted to intervene.
