

PETITION TO INTERVENE**

Freedom Ring Communications, L.L.C. d/b/a BayRing Communications (BayRing) hereby respectfully moves that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) grant BayRing permission to intervene as a party in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to Commission rule Puc 203.02(a) and RSA 541-A:32 (I). As set forth more fully below, the Commission should grant BayRing's request to intervene because the Company may be substantially and directly affected by the Commission's actions in this proceeding.

In support of this Motion, BayRing states the following:

1. BayRing is a Maine Corporation that is a public utility as defined in RSA 362:2 and that is regulated by the Commission. BayRing provides telecommunications services to residential and business customers and access services to utilities as defined in RSA 362:2 pursuant to authority granted by the Commission.

2. As a telecommunications provider, BayRing's rights, duties, and other interests may be affected by this proceeding. The issues raised in the Order of Notice in this proceeding could be significant to BayRing's future operations and BayRing has interest in determining that decisions or policies from this docket do not adversely impact BayRing or its customers.


3. It would serve the interests of justice for the Commission to grant this intervention.
