

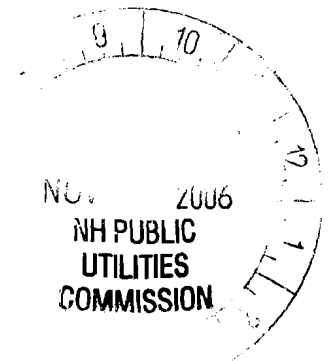

Dear Ms. Howland:

Granite State Electric Company d/b/a National Grid would like to clarify the suggestion made by some commenters that the PUC 900 Rules currently impede customers' ability to interconnect systems larger than 25 kilowatts to the utility system. Rather, although the PUC 900 Rules primarily address smaller interconnections in the context of net energy metering, customers can and do install larger systems in consultation with the electric utilities after an impact study is performed.
