
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL TESTIMONY

Unitil Energy Systems, Inc., (“Unitil”) moves the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) for leave to file supplemental testimony in this proceeding. Unitil submits that good cause exists to allow the submission of this supplemental testimony:

1. The supplemental testimony consists of four (4) pages of pre-filed testimony prepared by Unitil witness George R. Gantz, Senior Vice-President, who submitted pre-filed direct testimony on September 17, 2007.
2. As a result of it review of the testimony and data responses filed by all parties and discussions held at the Techincal Session on October 2, 2007, and discussions with Unitil’s senior management, the Company undertook a follow-up evaluation of programs it might undertake in response to the policy direction identified by the Commission in this docket.
3. The purpose of this supplemental testimony is to provide the Commission and the parties the results of this follow-up evaluation and to indicate the steps Unitil expects it will be able to take to implement real-time and time-of-use pricing for its customers. Accordingly, Unitil submits that this supplemental testimony will assist the Commission in its investigation and deliberation of the issues in this docket.


For all of the foregoing reasons, Unitil moves for leave to file the attached Supplemental Testimony of George R. Gantz.
