Please accept this letter as the response of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("Unitil"), in support of Public Service Company of New Hampshire's ("PSNH") Motion for Rehearing of Order No. 24,763 filed on July 23, 2007 ("Motion") in the above-captioned proceeding. Unitil concurs with the substantive and procedural issues raised by PSNH in its Motion, and shares PSNH's concerns about the unintended impacts to customers, particularly residential customers, of the Commission's Order.

Unitil submits that, and as set forth by PSNH, significant evidence concerning the cost, customer impact, practicality of implementation, and complexity of the management of the billing data necessitated by the Order was not available on the record to the Commission, and therefore a rehearing of this matter is warranted. Accordingly, Unitil recommends that the Motion be granted.
