PETITION TO INTERVENE OF HESS CORPORATION

In accordance with the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure ("Rules") and its August 15, 2006 Order of Notice, Hess Corporation ("Hess") hereby petitions to intervene in the above-referenced proceeding.

Hess states the following in support of its petition:

- Hess is a Natural Gas Supplier now serving retail gas customers in the State of New
 Hampshire with a principal place of business at One Hess Plaza, Woodbridge, New
 Jersey. Hess recently acquired additional New Hampshire customers formerly served by
 Select Energy, Inc.
- 2. On August 21, 2006, EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc. d/b/a/ KeySpan Energy Delivery New England ("EnergyNorth") filed its 2006 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) covering the period of November 1, 2006 and October 31, 2011.
- 3. Hess has a substantial and specific interest in intervening in this proceeding due to the investigation as to whether the Company needs a capacity reserve to assure adequate resources in the event of a capacity exempt firm transportation customer supply disruption, and the potential for EnergyNorth to plan for a capacity reserve may have a substantial affect on Hess' business and Hess' customers. Hess currently serves New Hampshire customers, and additional costs imposed on either Hess or its customers may

have an impact on the competitive market under which Hess and other New Hampshire

suppliers operate. No other party is in a position to adequately represent Hess' interests

in this proceeding. Accordingly, any decision in this proceeding will substantially and

specifically affect Hess.

4. Given its position as a Natural Gas Supplier, Hess will have information that will aid the

Commission in its evaluation of EnergyNorth's proposal.

5. On August 15, 2006, the Commission issued an Order of Notice establishing September

28, 2006 as the date for the filing of Petitions to Intervene. Hess' Petition to Intervene is

timely and consistent with the Commissions rules.
