On July 28 and 30, 2009, Staff and parties conducted a technical session in the nature of a deposition in accordance with secretarial letters issued by the Commission on July 21 and July 24, 2009. Parties were invited to provide comments and recommendations for further action by September 3, 2009.

By this letter, One Communications indicates its support of the attached CLEC Key Issues/Recommendations (attached as Attachment 1) which were jointly drafted and endorsed by fourteen Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont CLECs. The CLEC Key Issues/Recommendations were provided to FairPoint at a Transition Workshop held in Vermont in Docket No. 7270 on August 10, 2009.
