

Dear Secretary Howland:

Enclosed please find for filing an original and seven (7) copies of a *Supplemental Statement in Support of Confidential Treatment of Annual Reports*.

On October 2, 2008, Global NAPS, Inc. filed CLEC-3 Annual Reports for 2005-2007 along with a letter seeking confidential treatment of those reports. Although Global NAPS, Inc. filed the request for confidential treatment as a separate matter, the Commission noticed a hearing to determine confidentiality of the annual reports under Docket DT 08-028. Consequently, Global NAPS, Inc. is filing the enclosed supplemental statement in the above-captioned docket.

Global NAPS, Inc. is filing the supplemental statement with the hope that the Commission Staff will recommend that Global NAPS, Inc.'s financial information should be treated as confidential.

If Commission Staff files such a recommendation, Global NAPS, Inc. does not believe that a hearing concerning confidentiality of the information in Global NAPS, Inc.'s annual reports will be necessary tomorrow. The parties to Docket DT 08-028 that have signed protective agreements have received copies of the annual reports and have not filed objections to their confidential treatment by the Commission. There would remain one outstanding issue for a potential hearing, and that would concern the confidentiality of balance sheets and income statements that the Commission has ordered Global NAPS, Inc. to file. However, those reports have not yet been prepared by Global NAPS, Inc.'s accountants and have not yet been filed with the Commission. Consequently, a hearing on the confidentiality of Global NAPS, Inc.'s balance sheets and income statements would be premature. Global NAPS, Inc. requests that, if the

confidentiality of its annual report information is resolved, tomorrow's hearing be cancelled and a new hearing be set once Global NAPS, Inc. files its income statements and balance sheets.
