

Please comment on how long the company has contemplated or planned for an interconnection between its two core systems, including relevant dates to the extent applicable.

Answer: The feasibility of the Atkinson interconnection was explored after installation of the Hampstead tank and the interconnection with the Kent Farm system to the Hampstead core was completed in 2005.

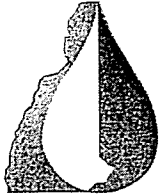
Please indicate the extent of engineering review of the proposed interconnection to date.

Answer: The pressure & hydraulic grade lines for the proposed interconnection have been evaluated and the length of the interconnection has been surveyed and drafted.

Staff 2-3

Please comment on the current status of the GIS water system mapping and hydraulic model for which financing was approved in DW 08-033.

Answer: The GIS mapping system has not been started. HAWC has decided to delay the GIS mapping for an indefinite period. The hydrology model will be pursued this year.

ANSWERS BY THE COMPANY

Staff 1-1

Paragraph 2 of the petition indicates the interconnection has the support of NHDES, with similar statements appearing on p. 3 of Mr. St. Cyr's testimony and at the top of p. 2 of Mr. Morse's testimony. Please provide any correspondence from NHDES in support of these statements.

ANSWER: This is evidenced by the DES provision of \$1,100,000 in financing and a \$312,840 grant for funding the project.

Staff 1-2

Regarding the proposed booster/metering station referenced in Exhibit 3, schedule SPS-5 and at the bottom of p. 2 of Mr. St. Cyr's testimony, please indicate:

- a) The location and purpose of the station;
- b) How and when the need for the facility will be determined;
- c) The timing of its construction in relation to the interconnection itself;
- d) The likelihood it will be funded with SRF monies.

ANSWER:

- a) The location of the station will be determined after a Professional Engineer (PE) has reviewed the hydraulics of the two systems and the plans are finalized.
- b) The need for this facility will be determined after the final design has been drafted by a PE.
- c) The station will be constructed concurrent with the installation of the water main.
- d) The company has included \$60,000 for the proposed booster station in the \$1.1 M budget submitted to DES.

Staff 1-3

Will the interconnection main and any associated facilities be put out to bid? If not, please explain.

ANSWER: DES rules require that the Company put the job out to public bid.

Staff 1-4

Please indicate the current status of a proposed .5MG water tank under consideration in Atkinson.

ANSWER: The Company has no plans to do the Atkinson tank in the immediate future as the interconnection will provide access to the stored water at the existing tank in Hampstead.

Staff 1-5

Does the company have any estimate of customer growth along the route of the proposed main or elsewhere within the proposed franchise area?

ANSWER: See attached.

Staff 1-6

Is additional fire protection anticipated along the route of the proposed main?

ANSWER: Yes. Fire protection is anticipated along the route of the proposed main.

Staff 1-7

The proposed franchise area appears to leave a gap in the vicinity of Lexington Road, Lamplight Drive, Olde Common Drive and Concord Road (all or portions of lots 17/26, 17/26-1, 17/26-2, 17/26-3 and 17/86). Was this gap intentional? Please explain.

ANSWER: See attached plan. Lot 17/86 is a development known as the Commons, which has a private community water system. The proposed franchise area left out the remaining lots (17/26, 17/26-1, 17/26-2 and 17/26-3) as they were non-contiguous to the proposed franchise request. If customer demand requires it, the Company will petition to franchise those lots when that occurs.

Staff 1-8

Paragraph 6 of the petition references an attachment or schedule SPS-1 (State of NH conditional approval letter - see also reference to "letter of commitment" at top of p. 4 of the petition). No such attachment or schedule was included in the filing. Please provide.

ANSWER: Rick Skarinka notified the Company by phone call. Attached is an e-mail from Rick Skarinka dated May 20, 2008 informing the Company that he has \$1,100,000 available for the project.

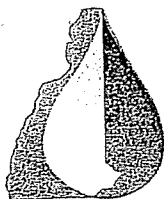

This letter is written to inform you that Hampstead Area Water Company, Inc. (HAWC) plans to install a water distribution main along NH Route #121. The work is proposed to be undertaken during the summer of 2009. The water main will be installed in the road along your property. You are being contacted to make you aware of our plans and to ask if you would like to connect to the water main for a potable water service.

This extension is part of a long range plan which includes water source stability, drought protection, water conservation, and the potential for increased fire protection. HAWC has consulted with both the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (PUC) and the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (DES) as part of its emergency plan.

On June 17, 2008 HAWC filed a petition with the PUC for authority to borrow long term debt to fund this project. HAWC intends to borrow \$1,100,885 from the State Revolving Loan Fund (SRF) administered by the DES at an interest rate of 3.488%. The proceeds of the loan will be used to finance the construction of this interconnection.

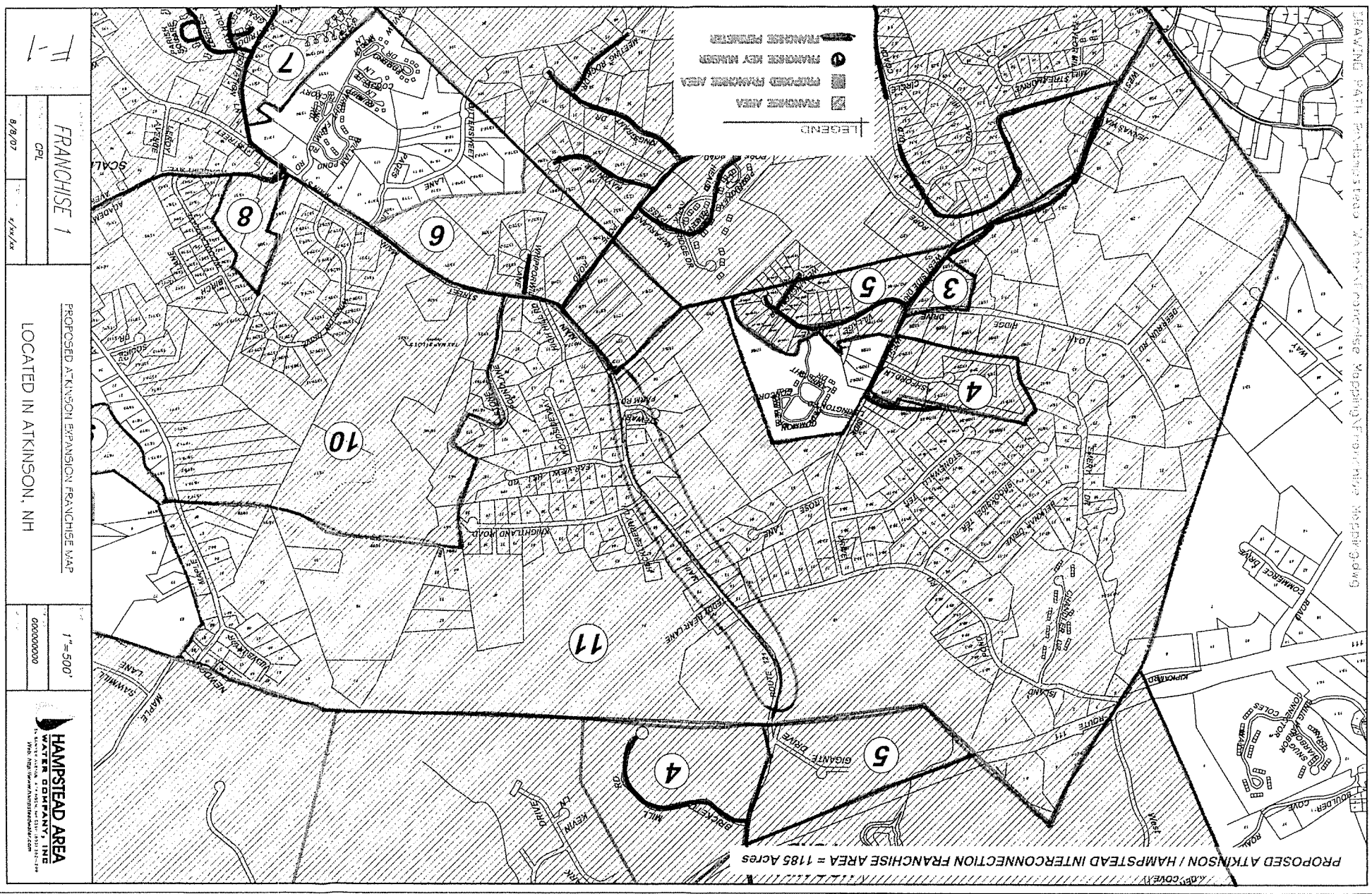
