Re: Application for Renewable Energy Source Eligibility

Dear Ms. Howland:

Sheldon Energy LLC (“Sheldon”) respectfully submits its application for the High Sheldon Wind Energy Center (“Facility”) as a class I renewable energy source under RSA 362-F and Puc 2500 of the State of New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission’s rules. Filed concurrently with its application is a Motion for Confidential Treatment of the Purchase and Sale Agreement for Contract Renewable Energy Credits Between Sheldon and NextEra Energy Power Marketing, LLC.

The Facility is a wind-energy plant with 75 General Electric, Model SLE, 1.5 MW wind turbines. The Facility totals 112.5 MW (nameplate) of installed wind-energy capacity. The Facility’s initial, commercial-operation date was March 13, 2009.

Both the New York Public Service Commission and the Maine Public Utilities Commission have qualified the Facility as a renewable resource. On January 17, 2008, the New York Public Service Commission found that the Facility was based on “renewable resource technology,” and would provide “clean and renewable supplies of electricity.”¹ Similarly, the Facility was certified as a Class I, new renewable resource that is eligible to satisfy Maine’s new renewable resource portfolio requirement pursuant to Chapter 311, § 3(B) of the Maine Public Utilities Commission’s rules.²

New England Power Pool Generation Information System (“GIS”) certificates will be issued for the portion of the energy produced by the Facility that will be physically delivered from the New York Independent System Operator system into the ISO New England control area and the New England Power Pool. Such energy will be used to serve electricity load within the ISO New England control area. An application for a GIS code for the Facility is currently being pursued.


