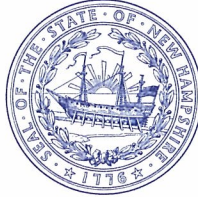

Data Requests to Comcast

Dear Ms. Howland:

On September 13, 2010, Commission Staff issued a series of Data Requests to Comcast in the above docket. On that day, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a Motion to Quash the requests, and Staff objected to that motion on September 14, 2010. On September 15, 2010, TDS filed a letter concurring in Staff's objection. On September 23, 2010, New Hampshire Legal Assistance (NHLA) filed a Motion *in Limine* to exclude any responses from Comcast from the record in this docket. No responses have been received from Comcast.

Staff has now determined that the requests and the potential responses are not necessary and, in the interest of administrative efficiency, elects to withdraw the requests issued on September 13, 2010. TDS has stated that it does not object to Staff withdrawing its requests. As Staff is withdrawing the questions, both the Motion to Quash filed by the OCA and the Motion *in Limine* filed by NHLA are moot.
