On July 20, 2012, the Commission received US Energy Management Services' notice of intent to renew its registration to provide electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rules Puc 2003.05. US Energy Management Services first registered in 2008 and its registration expired on July 25, 2012. Pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), Energy Management Services' renewal application was due 60 days prior to the expiration date. In its application, Energy Management Services requested a waiver of the rule. Considering the general confusion among aggregators regarding the adoption of a revised Puc 2000 on August 25, 2010, Staff recommends that the application be considered as a renewal for this instance only and that the Commission grant the waiver of Puc 2003.05(a).

The application has been reviewed and the Company has complied with the requirements of Puc 2006.02. Staff recommends that US Energy Management Services' application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service in New Hampshire be approved.
