

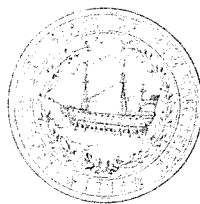

Re: DE 12-244, Exeter Wastewater Treatment Plant Eligibility Request for Class II Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) Generated by the 50 kW Photovoltaic Array at 13 Newfields Road, Exeter, NH 03833, Pursuant to RSA 362-F.

Dear Mr. Mitchell:

On July 31, 2012, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Revolution Energy requesting Class II REC certification of the photovoltaic array at the Exeter Wastewater Treatment Plant, as a renewable energy source pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law.

Pursuant to 2505.08 a customer-sited source with a capacity of 100 kilowatts or less shall demonstrate its eligibility to acquire certificates by submitting an application under this section. Puc 2505.08 (b)(5) states that the application shall include a complete list of the equipment used at the facility, including the meter and, if applicable, the inverter. The information provided in the application includes equipment pamphlets for panels, an inverter, and a meter, but this does not suffice for a list. The list typically states the number of panels used in the installation and each panel's output which provides the Commission with verification of the output. In order to finish review of your application and recommend approval, it is imperative that the Commission receive a complete list of the equipment used.

Submission of the above modification and verification must be received by the Commission to complete your application. Until such time, it cannot be processed. If the requested information and documentation are not provided within ten business days of the date of this letter, your application will be denied without prejudice. Please refer to docket number **DE 12-244** in all future correspondence with the Commission.
