On behalf of EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc. d/b/a Liberty Utilities ("the Company"), I am writing to inform the Commission that, as detailed in Section I.K of the 2013-2014 CORE New Hampshire Energy Efficiency Programs Plan and in Section II(A) of the Settlement Agreement approved by Order No. 25,462, the Company will be transferring funds within the Commercial and Industrial ("C&I") sector of its CORE gas energy efficiency programs in order to meet year end demand for its Large Business Energy Solutions program and balance the projected underspend within its Small Business Energy Solutions program.

The table below reflects the approved budgets for the Company's 2013 CORE New Hampshire Energy Efficiency programs and the transfers. As noted in the table, the Company intends to transfer \$218,658 from the Small Business Energy Solutions program into the Large Business Energy Solutions program. Each of these transfers is within the 20% limit approved in Order 25,462.
