Dear Ms. Howland:

North American Power and Gas, LLC ("NAPG") submits the following brief letter in lieu of Objection to the Public Service Company of New Hampshire ("PSNH") February 19, 2013 Supplemental Motion to Dismiss ("Supplemental Motion"). The Supplemental Motion seeks to add lack of standing of the original Petitioner in this docket, PNE Energy Supply LLC ("PNE"), as an additional ground to its pending Motion to Dismiss. Supplemental Motion, p. 1.

In light of the facts that (1) the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") elected to publicly notice the PNE petition and solicit interventions from persons potentially affected by the issues raised by PNE, (2) the Commission granted party status to NAPG and several other intervenors that retain legal standing in the proceeding irrespective of PNE's current status, and (3) the issues at stake in this proceeding have substantial public interest implications that go beyond the narrow interests of PNE, NAPG requests that the Commission not dismiss this proceeding based on arguments contained in the Supplemental Motion. With respect to the remaining dismissal arguments offered by PSNH, NAPG continues to rest on its January 16, 2013 Objection to Motion to Dismiss.
