On October 2, 2012, Revolution Energy, LLC submitted an application for the certification of the electrical production from the .14 megawatt (MW) Favorite Foods, Inc. (Favorite Foods) photovoltaic (PV) array located at 29 Interstate Drive, Somersworth, NH, for Class II renewable energy certificates (RECs), pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) law. Staff has determined the application was complete in the initial filing in accordance with New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2500. The application and all submitted information have been reviewed and staff recommends approval effective October 2, 2012.

Class II eligibility requires a facility to produce electricity from solar technologies and to have initiated operation after January 1, 2006. The application indicates that the Favorite Foods PV array began operation on August 2, 2012. The total nameplate capacity of the PV array at Favorite Foods is .14 MW; the facility's New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System facility code is NON 34313.

Pursuant to Puc 2502.13, Favorite Foods is a customer-sited photovoltaic facility; therefore, its output is not recorded in the NEPOOL Market Settlement System and, as a result, must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application states that Thomas Kelly will serve as the facility's independent monitor as required by the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5).

Staff has determined that all necessary information has been provided to demonstrate the Favorite Foods PV array's eligibility for certification to produce New Hampshire Class II RECs. Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission hereby certifies the Favorite Foods PV array as a Class II renewable energy source effective October 02, 2012. The New Hampshire single certification code for the Favorite Foods PV array is NH-II-12-077.
