Dear Ms. Howland.

I am writing on behalf of the Electric Utility Restructuring Legislative Oversight Committee RSA 374-F: 5, Ch. 129:2, Laws of 1996 to request that the Commission open a docket related to RSA 369-B:3-a and Public Service Company of New Hampshire's (PSNH) ownership of electric generating plants. Specifically, we request that the Commission conduct the necessary analysis to determine whether it is now in the economic interest of PSNH's retail customers for the company to complete restructuring and divest its' interest in its' generation plants.

In order to inform any legislative action that may be necessary to complete divestiture or make other statutory changes related to these issues, we respectfully request that you report back the findings of your analysis to the Electric Utility Restructuring Legislative Oversight Committee on a a preliminary basis by February 15, 2014 and a final report to be issued by April 1, 2014.
