

Revolution Energy Aggregation

Dear Mr. Fanning:

On October 18, 2013, the Commission received an email from Abraham Fanning (Fanning), requesting REC eligibility transfer of his 0.012 megawatt (MW) photovoltaic array to Revolution Energy Aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.12. The Commission originally certified the Fanning array as a Class II renewable energy source effective March 4, 2013. The facility's current New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System facility code is currently NON 36099.

Revolution Energy Aggregation was approved as an aggregator of New Hampshire customer-sited sources August 8, 2013¹, pursuant to Puc 2506. The New England Power Pool Generation Information System (NEPOOL – GIS) has approved Revolution Energy Aggregation as NON 15299.

This facility is a customer-sited source and its output is not recorded in the NEPOOL Market Settlement System. As a result, its output must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. Thomas Kelly will continue to monitor the facility's output as required by the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5).



Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission hereby approves the transfer of the RECs generated by the Fanning photovoltaic array to the Revolution Energy Aggregation effective October 18, 2013.

Please be advised that, pursuant to Puc 2505.12, the Commission has approved the transfer of renewable energy certificate (REC) eligibility for Abraham Fanning's (Fanning) 0.012 megawatt (MW) photovoltaic array to Revolution Energy Aggregation effective October 18, 2013.

The Fanning facility was initially approved for REC eligibility on March 4, 2013. Thomas Kelly will continue as the facility's independent monitor. The NEPOOL GIS facility code for the Revolution Energy Aggregation is NON 15299; the New Hampshire identification number will remain NH-II-13-022.
