On December 21, 2017, Pope Industries, Inc. d/b/a Pope Energy (Pope Energy) filed a request to withdraw its registration as an electric load aggregator in New Hampshire. Pope Energy confirmed in a separate communication that it has no electric aggregation customers in New Hampshire and has not served any such customers in the past 90 days. Pope Energy therefore had no customers to whom a notice of service discontinuation should be sent at least 30 days prior to its request for withdrawal. Staff has also confirmed that Pope Energy has no pending customer complaints against it.

Staff has reviewed the request and determined that it meets the requirements for the withdrawal of Pope Energy's electric load aggregator registration, pursuant to Puc 2003.08(b) and (c). Staff therefore recommends that the Commission approve Pope Energy's request to withdraw its electric load aggregator registration, effective as of the date of the letter confirming such approval.
