This letter serves as confirmation that Eagle Creek Renewable Energy purchased Lakeport Hydroelectric One, LLC in a transaction that closed on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013. As of June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2013, Lakeport Hydroelectric One is entitled to all energy, capacity and REC revenue produced by the facility.


Lakeport Hydroelectric One owns and operates all equipment associated with energy generation. The company leases the rights to use the dam and an adjacent piece of land from the New Hampshire Water Resources Board. The lease commenced on December 29<sup>th</sup>, 1982 and will remain in place for 50 years, until 2032 with an option to extend.

Eagle Creek has confirmed with the GIS Administrator that the facility's GIS account will transfer to Eagle Creek ownership on October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013.
