I noticed on the LU website, LU is before you on Feb. 19 asking for a rate increase from the current rate of approximately \$1.10/therm to \$1.24/therm for the gas supply charges of the LU bill (Docket number DG 13-251). In the year ago period the price was \$.68/therm. I do not claim to understand the factors that go into the assessment of reasonable rates for natural gas, but I want to bring to the board's attention the unanticipated financial burden that is created by close to a doubling in price of a resource that is a substantial (20-30%) component of total expenses required to operate a building in winter in NH.
