On May 2, 2014, Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) filed a request, with supporting testimony and schedules, to make a mid-year adjustment to its Stranded Cost Recovery Charge (SCRC) rate on a service-rendered basis effective July 1, 2014. The SCRC recovery mechanism was established pursuant to the Agreement to Settle PSNH's Restructuring approved in Order No. 23,549. In this filing, PSNH proposes to decrease the SCRC from the current rate of 0.35 cents per kilowatt hour (kWh) to an average rate of (0.06) cents per kWh.

The Restructuring Agreement defined PSNH's stranded costs and categorized them into three different parts (Part 1, Part 2 and Part 3), all of which are recovered through the SCRC rate. Part 1 SCRC is calculated to recover the principal, net interest, and fees associated with the rate reduction bonds (RRBs). The RRBs were fully amortized as of May 1, 2013. Part 2 costs are "ongoing" stranded costs consisting primarily of the over-market value of energy purchased from independent power
