On March 24, 2014, the Commission received applications filed by Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC<sup>1</sup> (Knollwood Energy) for Pugliese Contracting (Pugliese); Buckley Gould Real Estate (Buckley Gould); and, Warren Goldblatt (Goldblatt). Knollwood Energy is requesting Class II New Hampshire Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) eligibility for these entities' photovoltaic (PV) arrays pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law<sup>2</sup> and inclusion in the Knollwood Energy aggregation.

The above-named facilities are customer-sited sources and meet the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the applications Staff recommends Commission approval for the Pugliese, Buckley Gould, and Goldblatt as eligible Class II facilities to be included in the Knollwood Energy aggregation, effective as of March 24, 2013.

Since these facilities are customer-sited sources, their output is not recorded in the ISO New England Market Settlement System and, as a result must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application for Pugliese lists Thomas Kelly of

Natural Capital, LLC, as the independent monitor; the Buckley Gould and Goldblatt applications list Paul Button of Energy Audits Unlimited. The independent monitor's responsibility is to verify the facility's output pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. Mr. Kelly and Mr. Button will report these facilities' total output annually to the customer and to the Commission. The monthly output will be reported quarterly to the NEPOOL Generation Information System as part of Knollwood Energy's Class II aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.09(h)(3).
