On April 21, 2014, Summerview Energy, LLC (Summerview) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Summerview's registration expired on March 26, 2014.

Staff has reviewed the information in the application and determined that the filing is complete. Staff noted that that, pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), Summerview's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration, on or before January 25, 2014. Because this is the first time Summerview has been tardy with its submission to renew its registration for electric aggregation, Staff recommends the Commission approve Summerview's renewal application to provide electric aggregation service, effective March 26, 2014, for a term of 5 years.
