Recoupment and Rate Case Expense

Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement Regarding Permanent Rates ("Settlement") approved by the Commission in Order No. 25,797 dated June 26, 2015 in Docket No. DG 14-180, I am enclosing the final calculations of the amount of recoupment and rate case expense. The Settlement required that EnergyNorth file this information by September 30, 2015.

The actual amount of rate case expense is \$411,782, which is \$13,309 higher than the estimated rate case expense shown on Attachment 3 to the Settlement. See Attachment A hereto. The primary reason for the increase is due to the inclusion of costs for the Commission Staff's consultant, which were not available at the time of the filing of the Settlement.

The actual amount of recoupment is \$2,990,348, which is \$17,399 higher than the estimated recoupment amount shown on Attachment 2 to the Settlement. See Attachment B hereto. The reason for the increase is that therm sales for the months of May and June 2015 were slightly higher than the estimated amounts used in the calculation of the estimated recoupment.
