Re: FirstLight Fiber's Request for Licenses by Notification Pursuant to

RSA 371:1 7-b

Dear Ms. Howland:

Please accept for filing on behalf segTEL, Inc. d/b/a FirstLight Fiber ("FirstLight") our request for licenses upon notification pursuant to NH RSA 371:17-b for FirstLight's facilities crossing New Hampshire public waters and land that existed as of June 19, 2013, the effective date of the statute. Enclosed are the original and six copies of (1) FirstLight's Request for Licenses by Notification, (2) confidential List of Locations, and (3) Motion for Confidential Treatment. I also include one redacted copy of the List of Locations.

FirstLight's List of Locations comprises all of FirstLight's facilities located on what the company believes is New Hampshire state property pursuant to the statute. RSA 371:17-b clearly defines navigable waters, but it does not define state-owned land. For instance, state parks and forests and certain abandoned railroads are indisputably state-owned, but it is unclear whether the state owns other land set aside for public use, and other active and abandoned rail beds. In those cases we have used our best judgment.
