Dear Ms. Singer:

On December 10, 2015, Nordic Energy Services, LLC submitted an application to the Commission for registration as a competitive electric power supplier (CEPS). Commission Staff has reviewed the application and determined it is incomplete and therefore does not comply with the requirements of N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003. In particular, based on an initial review of the proposed customer contract as submitted, Staff identified the following requirement that has not been met and the related item which is missing from the application:

1) Reference in proposed contract to applicable termination charges.

Puc 2004.02(b) Each CEPS shall include in the written statement disclosing the terms of service required by (a) above, the following: (11) Any fees payable to the CEPS for early termination by the customer.

In order to complete your application, you should respond accordingly to the item described above. When responding, please address your letter to Debra A. Howland, Executive Director, and reference the docket number listed on the subject line of this letter.

Please note that a revised version of the contract will be subject to further review by Commission Staff.

Pursuant to Puc 2003.04 (h), please provide all information requested within 60 days of the date of this letter, on or before **March 5, 2016**. Puc 2003.04 (h) is copied below.

Puc 2003.04(h) If the commission has requested information or clarification to complete an application for registration, and such information or clarification is not provided within 60 days of the request, the commission shall suspend the application. If, after 120 days of the date of the request, the applicant has not provided the requested information or clarification, the commission shall reject the application. If an application is rejected, the application fee shall be forfeited and the applicant shall be required to submit a new application and fee prior to acting as a CEPS in New Hampshire.
