On May 6, 2016, Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC (FairPoint) filed a request seeking approval of an agreement with TDS MetroCom, LLC (TDS MetroCom).

This agreement would adopt the terms of an Interconnection Agreement between FairPoint's predecessor company Verizon New England d/b/a Verizon New Hampshire and YMAX Communications Corp. This earlier agreement was allowed to take effect on or about September 13, 2006, pursuant to Docket No. DT 06-089.

Staff recommends that the Commission allow the adoption of the Interconnection Agreement between FairPoint and TDS MetroCom to become effective by operation of law, 90 days after the date of the original filing, on or about August 4, 2016.
