In response to the Deficiency Letter and request for additional information dated June 8, 2016, EDF Energy Services, LLC would submit to the Commission the following information which was missing from the original application:

- 1. Please see attached the Certificates of Completion of EDI training and testing with each of the following utilities attached hereto as **Exhibit** 1, pursuant to Puc 2003. OJ (d)(l) Demonstration of technical ability to provide for the efficient and reliable transfer of data and electronic information between utilities and the CEPS:
 - a. Eversource Energy (Eversource);
 - b. Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities (Liberty); and
 - c. Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (UES).
- 2. Please see **Exhibit 2**, which is a draft of the Letter of Credit along with our request for a waiver of the five (5) year requirement which we will fine as proof of financial security pursuant to *Puc 2003.01(d)(4) Evidence of financial security, as defined in Puc 2003.03.*
- 3. Pursuant to Puc 2003. 01(d)(2) Evidence that the CEPS is able to obtain supply in the New England energy market, please see **Exhibit 3**, proof of membership in the New England Power Pool (NEPOOL).
