RE: Docket No. DE 16-873 Petition to Establish a Methodology for Billing Net-Metered Customers Under Rate G-1

Dear Ms. Howland:

On December 28, 2016, Liberty Utilities filed a petition to request a tariff change for Rate G-1 customers pursuant to Puc 903.02(p). In Order No. 25,995 issued on March 3, 2017, the Commission approved the tariff change. The tariff change allows the Company to implement a different methodology for billing customer-generators who take service under Rate G-1. With the change, any excess generation during on-peak hours will be credited to on-peak imported kWh in the customer's future bills, and any excess generation during off-peak hours will be credited to off-peak imported kWh in the customer's future bills. The tariff change does not include any rate changes; rather, only the methodology of billing customer-generators is being changed.
