DT 17-077: Revisions to Intrastate Tariff

Dear Ms. Wante:

On May 4, 2017, Bretton Woods Telephone Company (BWTC) submitted a revision to its Intrastate Access Tariff proposed for effect on July 1, 2017.

Staff reviewed the tariff, and by its memorandum dated June 1, 2017, recommended that the Commission extend the review period by up to an additional 30 days pursuant to RSA 378:6, IV. Staff's memorandum stated that the extension was necessary to afford sufficient time to determine whether the proposed tariff, including the revisions to over twenty rate elements, conforms to the requirements of the Federal Communications Commission. This extension is not expected to result in any change to the effective date of July 1.

The Commission has adopted Staff's recommendation and, pursuant to RSA 378:6, IV, extended the review period an additional 30 days to complete the investigation of the proposed revisions to its tariff.
