Application to Renew Registration as a Provider of Electric Aggregation Service

Dear Mr. Brodsky:

On June 26, 2017, Choose Energy, Inc. submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Staff reviewed the application and determined that it is complete.

Commission Staff filed a memorandum on June 27, 2017 recommending that the Commission grant a waiver of the renewal filing deadline under Puc 2003.05(a) and approve the renewal registration for a five-year term beginning on August 18, 2017.

The Commission has granted the proposed rule waiver regarding the renewal filing deadline and has approved the application for registration renewal effective as of August 18, 2017. The renewed registration is for a term of five years and expires at the close of business on August 18, 2022. Pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003.05(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the registration approved here, on or before June 19, 2022. Note that the Commission might not grant a rule waiver if there is any further instance of noncompliance with the renewal registration application filing deadline.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf. Please also be aware that the Commission has opened Docket DRM 13-151 to consider revisions to these rules. All non-confidential filings in Docket DRM 13-151 can be found at http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Docketbk/2013/13-151.html. The revised rules may

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contain different requirements for maintaining registration as a provider of electric aggregation service that might affect your registration.

Please note that, effective as of July 1, 2014, each registered electric load aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July 1 through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.
