	(2) Common direct or indirect ownership of at least ten percent	
	(3) Membership in the same household or immediate family, or	
	(4) Service as an officer, director, partner, employee, agent or fiduciary.	
(c) If a prohibited relationship pursuant to (b) exists between a source and any member of an aggregator's household or immediate family, then the aggregator shall be deemed to have such a prohibited relationship pursuant to this section.
