Dear Secretary Howland:

On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES"), enclosed please find the final results of its recovery of storm costs associated with the October 2017 Wind Storm. UES was allowed recovery of these costs over the three year period, May 2018 through April 2021.

In accordance with its tariff, UES is to file with the Commission, no later than sixty days after the conclusion of the recovery period, this final reconciliation, with the disposition of any remaining balance subject to Commission review and approval. As UES continues to recover, through its Storm Recovery Adjustment Factor, storm costs associated with the March 2018 Winter Storm Quinn, UES proposes to include the remaining balance of \$54,018 from the October 2017 Wind Storm in the reconciliation of Winter Storm Quinn. Upon conclusion of recovery of this storm, which is scheduled for April 30, 2022, UES will file its final reconciliation and propose a method to credit, or collect, any remaining balance.
