On behalf of Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities, I write to ask that the Commission amend the procedural schedule by extending until December 13, 2019, the Company's deadline for responding to Staff's discovery requests. For some reason the discovery list did not include me or the regulatory staff who are typically responsible for tracking responses, and thus the Company did not see Staff's requests until recently. The Company needs the additional time to prepare responses.
