Dear Director Howland,

As required in the May 30, 2002 NHPUC Order 23,980 and the Electric Assistance Procedures Manuals, attached are the following monthly reports for September 2019 on Eversource's Electric Assistance Program (EAP):

- 1. EAP System Benefits Charge (SBC) Reconciliation;
- 2. Number of active EAP participants and participation levels by discount tier and discount amounts per tier; and,
- 3. Aging Comparison Between EAP and Other Residential Customers.

On October 4, 2019, the Program Administrator was provided customer billing and payment information via File Transfer Protocol (FTP) as required by the Procedures Manuals.

For the month of October 2018, Eversource expenses were \$39,522.21 above the Net SBC Funding. The net cumulative amount remitted by the New Hampshire State Treasury for program expenditures since inception stands at \$12,392,699.28.

With respect to item #3 above, the Company notes an error that has only recently been discovered with respect to the data in the report. The dollar value in the report listed as "Total Included Accounts Receivable" does not actually report the total accounts receivable for EAP customers. Instead, that value actually reflects the current (calendar) month's billing amount for all EAP customers. The Company identified this error during a detailed review of various processes and reporting as part of the discovery process in its pending rate case, Docket No. DE 19-057. It is not clear how long this data has been mislabeled, nor is the Company able to determine when this error began.

The Company is in the process of correcting the manner in which the data is filtered and collected to assure that future reports will contain the correct information, but that correction has not yet been completed. As a result, this month's September 2019 report continues to reflect only the current month's billing dollar value as opposed to the Total Accounts Receivable dollar value for EAP customers.

This report is being filed electronically with one paper copy being sent to the Commission.
