Pursuant to PUC Rule 3003.08 of the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, UGI Energy Services, LLC ("UGIES"), a licensed Competitive Natural Gas Supplier ("CNGS") holding License No. DM 18-168, hereby provides written notice to the New Hampshire Department of Energy ("Commission") that it requests withdrawal of its CNGS registration and the prompt release from its financial security obligation and any subsequent assessment of Commission fees. In support of this request, UGIES stats the following:

UGIES has not served any customers in the state for over 120 days, having transferred all of its natural gas customer accounts in New Hampshire to Sprague Operating Resources, LLC ("Sprague"), another licensed natural gas marketer in New Hampshire. Sprague began assuming UGIES's customer contracts as of October 1, 2023 with full assignment completed by October 31, 2023. In transferring its customer book to Sprague, UGIES complied with the customer and LDC notification requirements set forth in PUC Rule 3004.06.

UGIES currently maintains a surety bond for the benefit of the Commission in the amount of \$350,000. UGIES will cancel and withdraw its bond at such time as the Commission formally terminates UGIES' CNGS registration.
