Dear Chairman Goldner,

Attached please find the Deerfield Community Power Plan for review and approval by the Commission pursuant to RSA 53-E:7. The Deerfield Community Power Plan was approved by the Deerfield Community Power Committee on November 15, 2023.

The plan is being submitted for Commission review and approval prior to being submitted to the Town's legislative body for approval as allowed under PUC 2204.01(a). Once the plan has been approved (or rejected) by the legislative body, majority vote at Deerfield Town Meeting and final approval by the Board of Selectmen, the Town will notify the Commission, Department of Energy, Office of the Consumer Advocate, and the distribution utilities serving Deerfield, [Eversource, Unitil, Liberty and the New Hampshire Electric Coop], of such final plan approval or rejection, as required under PUC 2204.01(g).


