**Tariff Filing to Revise Tariff NHPUC No. 84
and Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions
(SGAT)**

Order Suspending Tariff Filing for an Additional 30 Days

On September 28, 2001, Verizon New Hampshire (VZ-NH) submitted a tariff filing proposing revisions to tariff NHPUC No. 84 and its Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions (SGAT) pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Fourth Report and Order, In the Matter of Deployment of Wireless Services Offering Advanced Telecommunications Capability, CC Docket No. 98-147, adopted and released August 8, 2001. On October 11, 2001, Verizon submitted additional information in this docket, stating that, "In our effort to meet the required filing date, errors were made on the cost support and the accompanying tariff and SGAT pages."

The proposed changes affect provisions relating to both physical and virtual collocation arrangements as well as Cageless Collocation Open Environment (CCOE) and interconnection between collocated spaces. These changes include the introduction of new rates for manual intervention

and service connection/circuit provisioning (connection and disconnection).

Manual Intervention surcharges (non-recurring cost, per order) are proposed at \$43.44 for a normal intervention and \$47.79 for an expedited intervention, respectively. In the accompanying exhibit showing cost summary information, Verizon cites its Non-Recurring Cost Model as the source for all of the rates proposed in this filing, with the exception of five rate elements relating to their Dedicated Transit Service (DTS) offering Lit Fiber, where Service Connection charges for CO Wiring (normal and expedited) and Provisioning (normal and expedited) as well as the Lit Fiber Termination are priced on an individual case basis (ICB).

Based on the fact that new information was filed on October 11, 2001, Staff recommends that the tariff be suspended for an additional 30 days from the October 28, 2001 proposed effective date in order to allow for sufficient time for Staff to review the most recent changes to the tariff. We find that the late-filed materials warrant an extension of time for the Commission to conduct its review.

Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby

ORDERED, that Verizon New Hampshire's tariff filing

in this docket, pursuant to RSA 378:6, IV, is suspended for an additional 30 days.
