To the Parties:

On April 20, 2009, the Commission issued a secretarial letter directing the parties to file briefs on certain legal issues presented in this docket. Landowners of private land on which the utility pole easements are located were automatically deemed parties to the proceeding upon written notice that the landowner wished to participate. Briefs were filed by segTEL and PSNH. Written notice of participation and comments were received from Roderic Reyelt, Leonard A.
