What is the Pay for Performance program?

The Pay for Performance program comprehensively addresses the energy efficiency needs of the Commercial and Industrial sector by working with participants such as developers, building owners and their representatives, to improve energy efficiency of existing commercial and industrial buildings. Further information will be posted at www.NHP4P.com by January 21, 2011.

What is a Pay for Performance Partner?

A critical component of the *Pay for Performance* program is the development of a network of Program Partners. Approved Partners work closely with the participants to develop an Energy Reduction Plan that improves the energy efficiency of existing commercial, industrial, and large multi-family buildings and facilitates the installation of energy efficient measures.

Who can qualify to become a Partner?

Partners must demonstrate that they have previously acted in a **lead capacity** on at least three commercial and industrial projects for which comprehensive energy efficiency scopes of work were developed and fully implemented. The attached <u>Partnership Agreement</u> describes the qualifications in detail.

All approved Partners must attend a one-day Program Orientation seminar before submitting any Program Applications. The first Orientation seminar will be held in mid-to-late February 2011.
