2.	Would a ground source heat pump system that would serve a student dormitory building at a school be considered an eligible project for this RFP?	2.	Yes. At paragraph I.C.3 on page 3 of the RFP states "Projects must be in the non- residential sector in New Hampshire. Projects must be at commercial, industrial, public, non-profit, municipal, or school facilities, and may include multi-family buildings of four units or more. Residential projects are not otherwise eligible." A student dormitory at a school as described meets the definition of "non-residential" provided in the RFP. This, or any, geothermal ground source heat pump system would need to be properly equipped with sufficient metering equipment to meet the requirements of certification for thermal Renewable Energy Credits (Class I-Thermal RECS). The RFP states "Projects must utilize grant funds primarily for capital investments in new, REC-eligible renewable energy facilities, upgrades to existing facilities to increase REC production, or upgrades to existing renewable energy facilities that will qualify them as eligible for RECs." (See RFP at paragraph I.C.2. on page 3. Emphasis added).
