20.	I am working on plans for a 350 bed dorm in Keene, NH. This is commercial, but also residential. Is it possible that it fits this program?	That size multi-unit apartment or dorm building would be considered commercial and may be eligible to qualify for funding under this RFP. Other determining factors include technology and the capacity (kW) of the project. If the project is a solar one and 100 kW or less, it would not qualify for this RFP but would likely qualify for a rebate under the Commission's Commercial and Industrial Rebate Program.
