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Budget

- Total Budget: \$4,565,102
- Category 1: \$2,282,551
- Category 2: \$2,282,551



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Applicant Caps

- 30% Applicant Cap for Category 1: \$684,765
- 30% Applicant Cap for Category 2: \$684,765
- 10 applications
- Caps apply to Applicant and Affiliates - entities under common ownership, whether direct or indirect, of more than 25% of outstanding equity interests
- Must provide evidence of ownership and interests

These three companies are affiliates and their applications will count towards caps.

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Capacity & Incentive Calculation

- Maximum Capacity for Category 1:
 - ≤ 100 kW AC or thermal equivalent
- Minimum and Maximum Capacity for Category 2:
 - > 100 kW AC & ≤ 500 kW AC
- AC capacity
 - Maximum power output rating capacity of inverter (per specification sheet)
 - Same as for interconnection agreement as specified by utility
- Incentive Calculation:
 - Lesser of maximum power output rating of inverter capacity (Total Watts AC) and installed panel capacity (Total Watts DC)

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Eligibility Dates

- Systems \leq 100 kW DC: On or After March 7, 2015
- Systems $>$ 100 kW DC: On or After April 17, 2015



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Approval Period

- 6 months (starting from Step 1 approval date)
- May request extension 15 days prior to expiration
- Must have unavoidable and excusable reason for delay
- Must show substantial progress throughout approval period (interconnection process, permitting, etc.)
- Decisions by applicant that result in project delays are considered avoidable and inexcusable delays – no ext.



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Confidentiality

- Social Security Numbers, Taxpayer ID Number (TIN) and Employer ID Number (EIN)
- Other – File pursuant to Puc 200



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Registrations/Licenses

- Applicant (and host entity, if applicable) must be registered with the NH Secretary of State and in good standing throughout the rebate process.
- Installer must be registered with the NH Secretary of State and in good standing.
- Electricians and Plumbers must be licensed in NH.

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Required Documentation

- See Application



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Audit Requirements

- Conducted by qualified energy auditor : BPI-certified or RESNET-certified
- Waiver of the energy audit conditions:
 - C&I Buildings - proof of significant energy efficiency measures installed within 5 years prior to the Step 2 submission date and benchmarking data showing energy savings.
 - Group Net Metered Facilities that include residences - Home Performance with Energy Star recommended measures installed within 5 years prior to the Step 2 submission date (for the residential units only).
 - New Construction - construction is completed to current Energy Code standards.

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Initial Queue Position - Lottery

- All applications received on April 17, 2015 between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. will be included in the lottery
- Lottery drawing to be held on April 21, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. at NH PUC
- All applications received after April 17, 2015 at 4:30 p.m. will be placed in the category queue in order of receipt and after the applications in the lottery



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Queue Position



- Initial queue position determined by lottery (day 1), then by receipt date/time
- Preliminary Application Review:
 - Is application complete?
 - Includes all required documentation
 - Completely filled out
 - If application is incomplete, applicant will be notified and given 5 business days to provide requested information. After 5 business days, application will be held out of the queue until application is complete.
- Detailed Application Review:
 - “Complete” applications will be reviewed.
 - If additional information/clarification is required after application deemed complete, then applicant will be notified and given 10 business days to provide requested information/clarification. After 10 business days, application will be held out of the queue until requested information/clarification is received.
- After detailed review, if application meets all of the requirements, then application will be approved and incentive reserved.
- Queue includes those on the waitlist.
