Dear Chairman Goldner:

Enclosed for filing with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission are the Petition of New Hampshire Transmission, LLC (“NHT”) for Authority to Construct, Own, Operate and Finance Additional Transmission Equipment in Seabrook, New Hampshire, attachments to the Petition, and an Appearance. This filing concerns the Capacitor Banks Project on the grounds of the Seabrook Nuclear Generating Station in Seabrook, New Hampshire, which is also the subject of a docket pending before the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee, SEC Docket No. 2021-05.

NHT is currently a public utility in New Hampshire for the purpose of owning and operating the Seabrook Transmission Substation adjacent to Seabrook Station. This Petition is requesting that the Commission grant NHT the additional authority to construct, own, operate and finance the Capacitor Banks Project, adjacent to the Transmission Substation. This is a project which ISO-NE identified as a reliability need in the New Hampshire 2029 Solutions Study; ISO-NE selected NHT’s Project as the preferred solution to this reliability need.
