

4. I am submitting this affidavit in accordance with the Commission Order in this docket.





I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY
On April 11, 2022, New
Hampshire Transmission, LLC
(NHT) filed a petition with
the Commission to construct,
own, operate, and finance
new electric energy trans-
mission equipment and other
appurtenant infrastructure,
known as the Seabrook
Capacitor Banks Project
(Project), in Seabrook, New
Hampshire. Accompanying
its petition, NHT filed the
direct testimony of Richard
Allen, President of NHT, and
other witnesses.

On June 16, 2022, the New
Hampshire Department of
Energy (DOE) filed a notice
of intervention.

On July 7, 2022, the Commis-
sion held a duly noticed
prehearing conference.

On August 12, 2022, the DOE
filed the technical statement
of Jay E. Dudley and Mark P.
Toscano, NHT's Division of
Regulatory Support.

On August 22, 2022, NHT
filed a response to the techni-
cal statement of Jay E. Dudley
and Mark P. Toscano.

On August 24, 2022, the DOE
filed a response to NHT's
response dated August 22,
2022.

On August 25, 2022, the DOE
filed a motion for confidential
treatment relating to identi-
fied information in the techni-
cal statement of Jay E. Dudley
and Mark P. Toscano.

II. PARTY POSITIONS
a. New Hampshire
Transmission
In response to the DOE's
motion, NHT is a party to the
Lien Agreement will not
have a significant impact on

In response to NHT's re-
ply, the DOE amended its techni-
cal statement to contain
confidential information
not previously disclosed. The
DOE moved the Commission
to grant confidential treat-
ment to the information in
the DOE's technical state-
ment, and the DOE moved the
Commission to grant confi-
dential treatment to the infor-
mation in the DOE's techni-
cal statement.

According to NHT, the
Commission should grant the
petition because: 1) the
Project's need is demon-
strated by ISO-NE in the
transmission study; 2) ISO-NE
has identified the Project as a
preferred solution to address
the DOE 22-027 reliability
needs; 3) NHT anticipates that
proceedors in interest have
been recognized as having
the financial, technical, and
managerial capability to own
and operate the Project in
New Hampshire; 4) the
Commission is authorized
to grant and approve a
competing electric utility
franchise to determine if
it would serve the public good;
and 5) the Commission may
grant an independent trans-
mission company the author-
ity to provide transmission
service to the Project, which
the Commission determines
will serve the public good.

In support of its position that
NHT possesses the financial,
technical, and managerial
capability to own and op-
erate the Project in New
Hampshire, NHT submitted
the following testimony:
Richard Allen, President of
NHT, testified that NHT, its
staff, and its resources are
qualified to own and op-
erate the Project in New
Hampshire. NHT's facilities
meet the standards set forth
in the Code of Electric En-

The DOE concluded that the
financial statement request
represents a routine finan-
ce request. The DOE stated
that it views NHT's finan-
cing request differently than
if it were a typical finan-
cing request from a fully regulated
utility where financ-
ing has a direct impact on
ratepayers. According to the
DOE, the DOE even though
the financing affects the
Company's financial condi-
tion, because NHT is a trans-
mission utility, the resulting
requirements and customer
rates fall under the purview
of the Federal Energy Regu-
latory Commission (FERC)
and not under that of the
Commission. According to the
DOE, it is apparent that the
Company's unsecured debt
under the Lien Agreement will
not have a significant impact
on NHT's current capital struc-
ture.

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
