Revised FairPoint Communications, Stabilization Report – Bi-Weekly April 4, 2011.

Dear Ms. Bailey:

Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC, d/b/a FairPoint Communications – NNE (FairPoint) hereby submits a revised bi-weekly stabilization report for April 4, 2011 that was originally filed in error as a confidential report on April 12, 2011. This filing corrects that issue.

For the week ending 4/1 there were 106 pending late orders greater than 20 days. Of those orders 45 were held for “facility or equipment” reasons plus 23 were subsequently canceled, complete or held for customer/negotiated project commitment reasons as of the Friday “daily analysis”. 2 orders are Record orders. The 45 orders held for “facility or equipment” reasons were distributed with 25 in Retail and 20 ASRs. The remaining records are being addressed in the daily review procedure that triages the fallout and works the orders through the systems. Due to a data issue we are not able to provide updated data on this report related to the Flow Thru information on Tab 2 for the week ending 4/3. We will update the next bi-weekly report distribution with that data.
