Thank you again for your participation and contribution to yesterday's kickoff session. As discussed, we will not be taking minutes during this series of meetings; however, Staff believes that it may be helpful to track key takeaways from each session. Therefore, subsequent to each meeting going forward, I plan to provide the working group with a brief list of the salient issues/points covered during each meeting along with a specific agenda for the next meeting. In terms of yesterday's session, those issues/points were as follows:

- 1. These sessions are open to anyone who chooses to attend.
- 2. These meetings seek to build consensus on key issues based on the collective expertise and experiences of group participants.
- 3. The mission of the working group will adhere to the requirements of the Settlement Agreement and the PUC's Order in DE 17-136, i.e. review PI calculation methodologies and consideration of additional metrics (in particular income eligible participation and peak load reductions).
- 4. The review of the current PI formula and metrics provided by VEIC on 7/11/17 can be used as a starting point for the working group's discussion but is not exclusive, i.e. other approaches and ideas are encouraged and welcome.
- In reviewing additional metrics, the group should be mindful of the potential for conflicting metrics.
- 6. Program design must be a consideration.
- 7. Recognition of, and linkage to, the energy efficiency goals established under the EERS will be considered and reviewed.
- 8. Participants will share with others in the working group relevant research, studies, and other data points that may inform the group's discussion.
- 9. As work progresses and the examination of key issues come to a close, those participants seeking to offer specific proposals involving those areas are encouraged to do so in writing to the rest of the group.
- 10. Work involving the development of additional PI metrics will be shared with the EM&V Working Group.

Also, to stay on track in preparation for our next meeting on 2/21 (in addition to reviewing minimum incentive thresholds), our homework assignments from the previous kickoff meeting of 1/24 were as follows:

- 1. Review the EERS goals as established in DE 15-137 and as related to PI (Staff).
- 2. Review VEIC's proposed modifications to the current PI formula and metrics (Staff).
- 3. Review Synapse paper on PI (to be provided by Eric/Utilities).
- 4. Review New York study of PI (to be provided by Brian/OCA).
- 5. Review of historical progression of PI, re: DE 12-262 (Staff).
