2.	<p>Housing Authority question Tenant rent is income based as a certain percentage of total household income If tenant rent is \$300 and Utility Allowance is \$75 then tenant gets subsidy of \$75 from HUD. Assume tenant now participates in a shared solar project and gets a \$10/month reduction on electric bills. The next year the utility allowance would be reduced to \$65 so HUD only provides \$65 monthly utility allowance. Would this \$10/month be considered a direct benefit to tenant or not as per the RFP ruling/scoring?</p>	<p>In the hypothetical scenario as described in the question, the LMI customer would receive no direct benefit on a net basis, unless there is another source of benefit to the customer that would not affect the rental amount, utility allowance, or other public benefit program eligibility.</p>
